PREAMBLE

For God and Country, we associate ourselves together for the following purposes: "To uphold and defend the Constitution of the United States of America; to maintain law and order; to foster and perpetuate a one-hundred percent Americanism; to preserve the memories and incidents of our associations in the Great Wars; to inculcate a sense of individual obligation to the community, state, and nation; to combat the autocracy of both the classes and the masses; to make right the master of might; to promote peace and goodwill on earth; to safeguard and transmit to posterity the principles of justice, freedom, and democracy; to consecrate and sanctify our comradeship by our devotion to mutual helpfulness"

MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY

On July 30, 2019, President Trump signed into law the LEGION Act (Let Everyone Get Involved In Opportunities for National Service Act) that declares the United States has been in a state of war since Dec. 7th, 1941.

Therefore, any person shall be eligible for membership in The American Legion who was a member of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, or Coast Guard of the United States and assigned to active duty at some time since December 7, 1941, and has been honorably discharged or is still serving.

Because eligibility dates now remain open, all active-duty members of the U.S. Armed Forces are eligible to join The American Legion at this time, until the date of the end of hostilities as determined by the United States.
